### **Overview**

With many people moving out of the hills of Uttarakhand and going towards cities to find a better quality of life, hills are deserted. One of the ways to deal with the situation is to provide better skill development to the women in the Hills so that they can find and build opportunities in Uttarakhand as opposed to moving out and moving towards cities.

We are working extensively for the employment and livelihood of the people of Uttarakhand. We have been focusing on the women of remote areas of Uttarakhand. We are working for women's empowerment by providing them skill development training and making them independent so that they are able to not just help their own self but also the other members of their family too.

### How did we start?

Amrita Devi Foundation was started by some Vigilant, educated youth of Uttarakhand, who took a pledge to do something for the society. During their childhood, they have seen the difficult life of remote rural families of Uttarakhand. Even today there is a lack of basic necessities like education, health etc. No one could have known the plight of these poor families better than these young men.

In such a situation, these youth decided to do something for the economic upliftment of the poor and deprived families living in rural areas. It started with limited resources and some generous donations from big hearted people. The initiative was supported by many selfless activists and volunteers and the Amrita Devi Foundation's family began to grow.

Now Amrita Devi Women Skill Development Institutes which is a branch of Amrita Devi Foundation has started spreading very fast in rural areas of Uttarakhand.

### What is the problem in hand?

Much of the issues concerning women are there because "a systematic discrimination against females starts from childhood onwards." "The percentage of boys attending private schools is higher, while only 29% of girls study after the age of 19 and as a result, their participation in the workforce gets reduced. Therefore, we need to change things at the family level."

While women in India have shown their potential in every field including politics, literature and education since Independence, the status of the women in rural India is daunting and pathetic. The women in villages of India lead a tough, torturous and disconcerted life. They are the victims of a whole plethora of violence committed against them such as domestic violence, rape, molestation, forced marriage and dowry death. Female infanticide, early age pregnancy, sexual harassment and rejection are still prevalent in villages and suburbs of India

The situation of women in Uttarakhand is also more deteriorated. They have to work very hard. Women in the hills are seen working so much and so often, that her health is taken for granted. Dominated by men and guided by traditions, women on hills have to pass a very hard life. They have to cover a long distance to carry the drinking water for the family and collect fodder for their cattle. As a result their health remains ill. More than fifty percent of women suffer from anemia etc.

They need to be independent and for that they should learn skills which can provide them employment opportunities so that they can serve themselves, their families and nation.

In this program we have trained 10 students and provided them with free laptops. 4 students have been provided the training and they are currently under their internship program.

### 2. Tailoring:

We have started 3 centers respectively in Villages- Ghughuti, Parthola and Harda. 32 students have been enrolled in these centers and are learning these skills.


### 3. Computer Operator





A Training cum Employment Initiative

#### **NEED FOR THE PROJECT**

#### The Digital Marketing Course with employment assistance

As Uttarakhand is a hilly area in North India and of course the life out there is very tough and that is the reason people are moving and migrating to metro cities in search of better life and job opportunities for their families and themselves.

Life of women in Uttarakhand is dedicated to their families only. They live a very hard life there struggling with the basic necessities and dealing with problems of survival of their families.

After seeing people struggling so much in Uttarakhand for their basic survival and migrating to metro cities for employment we have decided to start creating employment opportunities for them in Uttarakhand itself.

India is going digital and we need to leverage this opportunity to train our girls in Uttarakhand on Digital Marketing and provide them assistance to work remotely for metro cities and earn for themselves and their families.

# **Objective**

The objective of this initiative is to provide training to the girls in Uttarakhand on digital marketing tools for 6 months including 2 months technical training, 1 month Personality Development classes and 3 months compulsory internship. Further provide them guidance and assistance in getting work/job/assignments. This will help in stopping the migration of people from hills to metro cities.

# Who should be made part of the project?

The world is changing and becoming digital and remote working is a new normal now, we can leverage this opportunity for the benefit of people in the hills. Anyone who has passed 12th standard/graduation and has basic knowledge of the internet can be made part of this project.

# What is the desired outcome of the project?

- Bringing the digital literacy to the people in hills
- Employment opportunities for people
- Less migration of people from hills to metros
- Enhancing the quality of the life of people from Uttarakhand

## **Brief of the program**

- In the first phase, 100 girls from Uttarakhand will be selected to participate in the course
- Selection criteria will be personal interview and written exam
- Amrita Devi Foundation will bear the cost of the computer for training purpose
- Amrita Devi Foundation will bear the cost of the training (INR 15,000 per person)
   too
- After completion of 2 months Digital Marketing training one month personality development classes are compulsory.
- After the successful completion of 3 month training, each participant will go through a 3 months unpaid internship as part of the course/on-the-job training.
- Amrita Devi Foundation will provide guidance and assistance to find the work for these participants as soon as they complete their 6 month course.
- Amrita Devi Foundation will provide laptop/desktop to the selected participants for their 6 month course.
- Participants will be paid for their work post their internship

### **Interview selection process:**

- Interested candidates will fill the form to enroll on the course. Her is the link to the form
- ADF team will shortlist candidates from the details received, Based on their education and financial status.
- Shortlist candidates will go for written exam(Examination form will be created by team)
- Candidates who will clear the written exam will go for a personal interview.
- After qualifying in the Personal Interview round the candidate will be selected for the course.
